## • ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION



DATE: 9<sup>TH</sup> -15<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2021








## • HOW TO BUILD A STARTUP ECOSYSTEM






### • **EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION**






#### • LEVERAGE THE REAL POTENTIAL OF YOUR TEAM






## • **ELECTRIC VECHILES**






#### • FRONT- END DEVELOPMENT


