

6. WEBINAR ON BASICS OF ARDUINO







16.WORD HUNT



The detailed schedule of the presentation were as follows:


- 1. IEEE PES Kerala Chapter session handled by Mr. Nithin V M (Student Representative, IEEE PES Kerala Chapter).

The event gave training in Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering & Allied Branches, Computer Science & Engineering / IT, and Mechanical Engineering and Allied Branches. The program was conducted as a flagship event from September 19th to September 21st. Each day hosted mentoring sessions from professionals from various fields of engineering to help students crack the formula for executing their B.Tech projects with ease. Through these sessions, the participants got an opportunity to learn more about the practical applications of engineering and how to come up with good ideas for their B.Tech projects. Each event was co-hosted by the PES Student





Branch Chapters of different colleges. The event had over 1000 registrations with 10 PES Student Branch Chapters of different colleges to co-host the events.

The PES Student Branch Chapters of IEEE SB College of Engineering Adoor and IEEE SB College of Engineering Trikaripur were privileged to get the opportunity to co-host the 3rd day of the event which was a session for Computer Science & Engineering/ IT students. The call for co-hosting the event came on September 9th, and we expressed our willingness for the same. The confirmatory email was received by the student representatives of the respective colleges on September 15th, and live registrations began on the same day itself. The event had over 300 registrations from students of many colleges and registrations for the event closed by September 20th.

Mr. Yadu Krishnan, Chairman of PES SBC, IEEE SB College of Engineering Adoor and Mr. Muhammed Shammas K P, Chairman of PES SBC, IEEE SB College of Engineering Trikaripur were the coordinators of the event.

The 2-hour session took place on September 21st at 9:40 am with around 100 participants present in the meeting room.

The event began with the welcome speech by Mr. Yadu Krishnan followed by the Inaugural speech by the special guest of the event, Dr. Sobha Manakkal, Vice-chair, IEEE PES Kerala Chapter. The guest of the event, Mr. Sreekanth P, Branch Counselor, IEEE SB College of Engineering Trikaripur then addressed the session, followed by the Vote of Thanks delivered by Mr. Muhammed Shammas K P. The session was anchored by Ms. Noora Nisar K, Execom Member, IEEE SB College of Engineering Trikaripur.

The first session of the event started at around 10 am. The speaker of the session was Mr. Vipin Kumar K S, who graduated in Computer Science & Engineering from MGUCE, and took M.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering from IIT Kharagpur. With 13 years of teaching experience, Mr. Vipin Kumar K S is currently the Associate Professor and Head of the Department of CSE in Government Engineering College Thrissur and pursuing a Ph.D. in Software Engineering from CUSAT. He is an active IEEE Member having several publications in international research journals, national and international conferences.





The speaker started the session by explaining what are Academic projects and the different project funding agencies that students can approach for help regarding their projects. There is a proper way in which a student should prepare the academic project and the speaker addressed all the procedures to be followed to execute an academic project and the skills and knowledge required by a student working on an academic project. The speaker then went on to address the selection procedure of a topic for the project. There are many ways to think of one, including the area of interest of the student, socially relevant projects, etc and then the speaker explained what an interdisciplinary project is and what interdisciplinary studies involve. Then the speaker talked about how to achieve excellence in the project by being always ready to explore options, thinking out of the box, thinking of industry collaborations, etc. The speaker also talked about the possible hurdles that the student might come across while doing their project and how to prepare and go about those hurdles. The speaker then went on to explain the main areas to focus on for executing the projects successfully including areas like cloud computing, additive manufacturing, Augmented Reality, etc which concluded the first session of the event. This was followed by a short break of 15 minutes. In the next session, the speaker started by talking about Institute Industry Collaboration, the keys to Collaboration Success. Academic Project Management was one of the main topics that were taken by the speaker which shed light on how to do proper project management which is a very beneficial topic for an engineering student. The speaker then moved on to explain about Software testing for projects. The speaker then took sessions on Large project management and different types of research. The speaker then talked about socially relevant projects with examples like 'Sanitizer Kunjappan 2.0' which were projects from our own state which inspired the participants to undertake more Socially relevant ideas for their B. Tech Projects. The speaker concluded the session by summarising the talk and pointing out important points for the participants to note and wishing the participants all the best for the future projects that they will be undertaking.

In the end, a Q&A session was held so that the participants could ask questions or ask any queries regarding the session. The session was very interactive and interesting and received positive feedback from the participants. The active participants of the session were awarded





the certificate of participation. We believe the participants found the session beneficial in improving their knowledge and helping them to execute their B.Tech projects. The IEEE PES Student Branches of College of Engineering, Adoor, and College of Engineering, Trikaripur are thankful to the IEEE PES Kerala Chapter for this opportunity to co-host such an educational and informative session.



Details and Rules:

- Create a working model (DIY) which works on the principle of electromagnetic induction and make a video showing the proper working.

- Evaluation will be based on the proper application of this principle in the model.

The competition made students aware of the works and contributions of the great electrical engineer, to a great extent. Entries were welcomed not only from graduate or undergraduate B.Tech students but also from the school students familiarising young talents with the applications of the 'Electromagnetic Induction' principle.





The winner of the competition was Animesh M of S7, EEE from College of Engineering, Trikaripur who submitted a video of a mini-Hydroelectric power plant working model showing the basic principle of 'Electromagnetic Induction' by generating electricity from the fast flowing water from the reservoir, rotating turbine and the rotor shaft of the 9v motor used. The motor used here acts as a generator producing electricity to lighten the connected LEDs.







A brief description about the IEEE Day was given by Mr. Muhammed Shammas KP (Chairperson, IEEE PES SBC CETKR) to the participants during the starting of the event.

For the better execution of this virtual competition, the debate was organized in 4 rounds each. Detailed agenda:

Round 1: Opening statement: Present the position on which side of the topic (for or against) along with a small elaboration and arguments on why and about the chosen side. (Time limit: 3 minutes for each team).

Round 2: Rebuttal Round: The participants can counter each other but it can be only when their chance comes. So ,initially a participant can answer the arguments first and can put the counter arguments for others after. But all these must be within the time limit. Round 3: Rebuttal with Interruption: A participant can interrupt others by raising their hands (Raise hand option in Zoom) so that the moderator shall give the participant opportunity for counter arguments at that moment itself by giving a small time limit. It is the decision of the moderator to entertain such an interruption at that time. (Time limit: 1 minute for each team, Interruption: 15 seconds.)

Round 4: Final statement: Each team summarizes their arguments or statements and concludes.(Time limit: 2 minutes for each team).

Points evaluation scheme:

Valid Points on arguments : Out of 5

Language (Diction): Out of 5





Counter arguments: Out of 5

Overall effectiveness: Out of 10.

Teams containing 2 participants each consisting of Team A,B,C,D were formed. Freedom for the team formation and for choosing either the proposition or opposition side for the debate were given. The topic for level 1 was 'Technology intensifies human interaction and communication skills'. Out of 4 teams containing 8 participants, 2 teams chose the proposition(A&C) and the other two opposition (B&D) sides. Level 1 included two debates (A vs D, B vs C) started from 4 pm where each debate duration was about 20 minutes. The winners of level 1 were Team C and Team D.




















32.STEM OUTREACH PROGRAM AS A PART OF EU-REKA 2020






















33.RELLIGO-TOGETHER WITH UNITY - INTRA-SB EVENT
























2) <u>Pixel- Photography Contest</u>























4) Report Writing Competition


The event ended with a Valedictory Function organized on 23rd December at 4pm. The function was to wind up the entire event and announce all the winners of the competitions.




