

## 1. REVIENS 2.0

Date: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2019

IEEE Student Branch of College of Engineering, Trikaripur organized its state level flagship event **REVIENS2.0** on February 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019. **REVIENS2.0** was a three-day event which comprised of relevant workshops, inspiring talks, games, activities and colorful cultural programs. A total of 40 delegates from various colleges like College of Engineering and Technology Payannur, Vimal Jyothi Engineering College, JCET, etc. joined us in this grand journey.

**REVIENS2.0** had had its great start on February 1, 2019. Delegates arrived at 12:00 pm noon and finished their registration process. The event was well coordinated by 30 volunteers who worked hard for the success of this event. After the inaugural ceremony, all delegates gathered for the ice-breaking session conducted by the volunteers. Delegates had a great time by participating actively in gaming section. All delegates had a wonderful time in gaming and activities section. All the sections of the events were effortlessly managed by the energetic volunteers. At 8:00 pm, our first speaker **MR. MUHAMMED THASVEER** arrived. Muhammed Thasveer is a 28-year-old actor, model, social media influencer, and adventurer. He is being inspirational since he had a tragic past in his life. He was left scarred following an accident in 2013 which resulted in his one leg being amputated. But this doesn't stop him from standing straight. He gradually started to gain strength from his disability and move towards his aim and fought endlessly for his future. The talk was so admirable and inspiring for the delegates.

Day 2 was a full day workshop consisting of 3 relevant titles - **REVIT, KOTLIN, WEARABLE ELECTRONICS**. REVIT was mainly for civil and architecture graduates. Kotlin was mainly for computer science and IT graduates and wearable electronics was mainly for electronics and electrical graduates. 7 delegates attended REVIT, 9 delegates attended KOTLIN and 23 delegates attended WEARABLE ELECTRONIC. These workshops were handled by professional staffs and the workshop started at 9:30 morning. Delegates shared their technical ideas with each other during the workshop. Workshops were interesting and helped participants to learn innovative techniques . Workshop ended at 5:00pm . A Treasure hunt was organized by the volunteers which excited the delegates. All the students actively participated on the treasure hunt. Day 2 winded up by colorful cultural program by the college students and volunteers which lasted until 9:30 PM.

He did his graduation in electronics and communication from Calicut University. 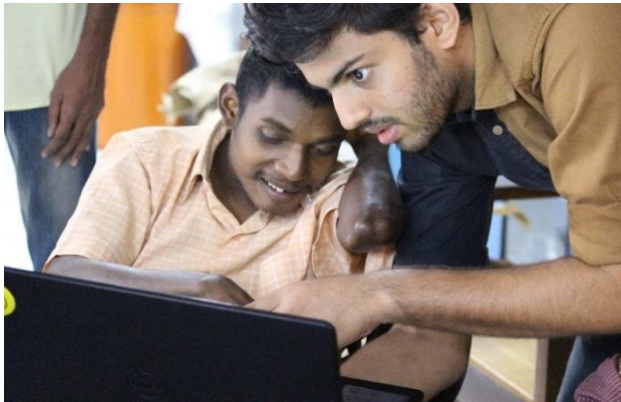


## **5. Visit to HOPE Rehabilitation Centre ,Pilathara**

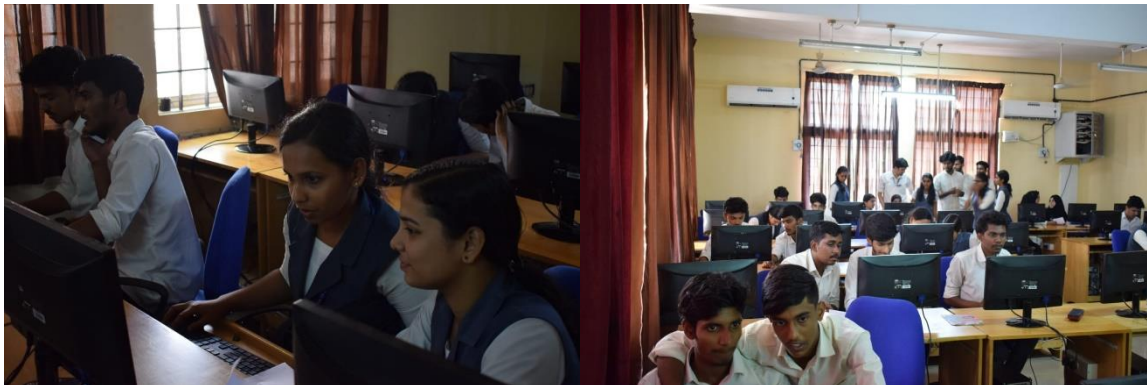
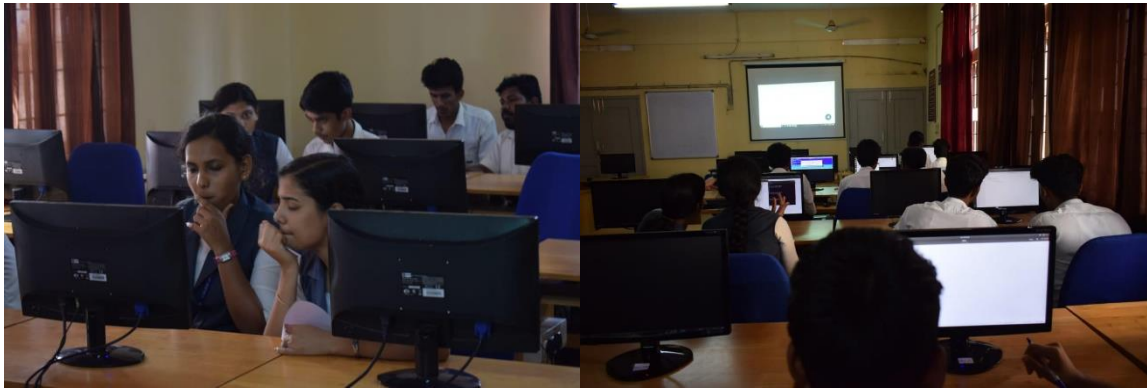




## 10.CODING COMPETITION

## 14.INTRA COLLEGE PES QUIZ COMPETITION

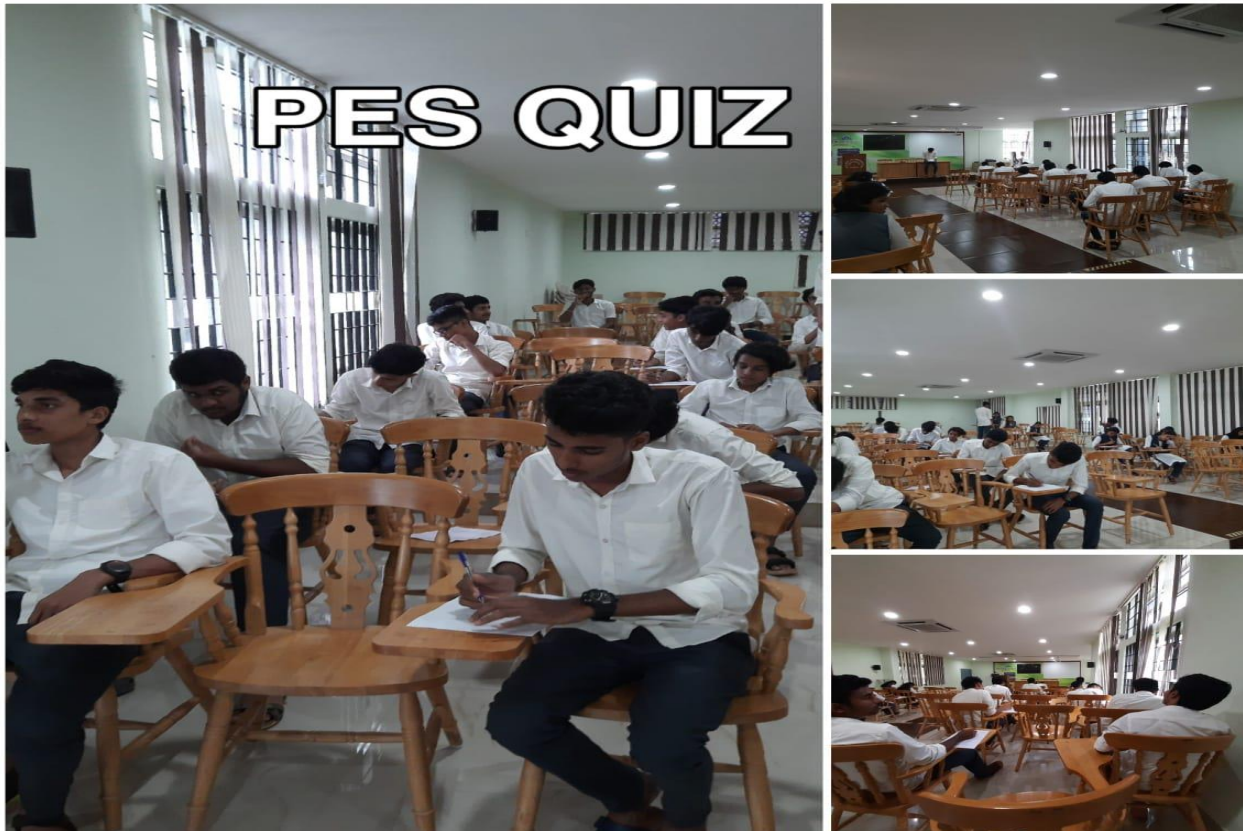
Date : 10<sup>th</sup> October,2019
