### ORDER

The Executive Committee vide resolution read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above resolved that the bond obligation for serving CAPE for the stipulated period after study leave of the faculty members shall be disposed with if the resignation is for accepting a government job under the advice of PSC and the higher studies were undertaken on LWA. Accordingly orders were issued implementing the decision of the Executive Committee vide proceedings read as 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above .

Later the 155<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Executive Committee held on 22.06.2016 vide resolution read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above resolved to re-examine the decision of the 154<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Executive Committee and to retrieve the amount waived from the faculty members in installments from those who have bonded obligation in CAPE and tendered resignation for accepting another employment.

But as there was a disparity for retrieving bond amount from the faculty members with bonded obligation on LWA/QIP, the matter was placed again before the 157<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Executive Committee for review.

The 157<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee as per reference 5<sup>th</sup> paper above re-examined the matter and resolved to limit the bond amount from the faculty members who are undergoing higher studies under QIP and LWA as shown below:
