The 137th meeting of the Executive Committee held on 16/05/2013 (137.13.2) resolved to increase the number of seats for deputation under QIP for M.Tech course from 13 to 17 from this academic year onwards and to issue strict instructions to the non-M.Tech Assistant Professors of Engineering Colleges that the pay in the revised pay band will not be allowed to them if they do not acquire M.Tech qualification within a period of three years as stipulated by Government/AICTE.
