DSpace is adaptable to various needs of Libraries and Information Centers and maintains in-built interoperability programs for application between various systems. It adheres to international standards for metadata. The five days workshop focus on developing digital library by using DSpace and integration of various open source library software.

3. Organising Knowledge in Digital Libraries
4. Preservation of Digital Materials
5. System Maintenance in online environment
