As per the AICTE “Approval Process Hand Book 2018-19” the requirement of teaching faculty against the sanctioned intake of students for under graduate course (B.Tech) have been revised from 1:15 to 1:20 in the cadre ratio of 1:2:6. Accordingly, the requirement of permanent faculty members in Engineering Colleges under CAPE has been recalculated in the ratio of 1:20. The 163rd Meeting of the Executive Committee as per resolution read as 3rd paper above has approved the revised allocation of teaching faculty positions (regular/adhoc) in the Engineering Colleges under CAPE.

In the circumstances, the total strength of regular faculty members in College of Engineering, Thrikaripur is refixed in the ratio of 1:20 with effect from the academic year 2018-19 onwards as detailed below:

As per the usual procedures followed in CAPE Engineering Colleges, 80% of the total strength of faculty shall be filled up on regular basis and remaining shall be filled up on adhoc basis. The maximum number of adhoc faculty members that can be engaged during the academic year 2018-19 is limited to 18 subject to workload in each semester. Internal arrangements are to be done to share the work load between the departments of CSE & IT, if necessary.

The Principal shall not replace the vacancy of Assistant Professors who are on deputation under QIP with adhoc faculty members due to additional financial commitment.
